Clinical Support Assistant

Could fund an hour long visit by a Clinical Support Assistant to a patient's home, to offer basic support, therapeutic care and guidance around making decisions at the very end of their life.

Bereavement Support

Could fund a session of Writing through Grief, a one hour, online bereavement support group allowing people to spend time with others going through a similar experience.

Physiotherapy

Could fund an hour-long session with one of our specialist Physiotherapists, using exercise and rehabilitation therapy to improve mobility and manage symptoms such as fatigue, pain and breathlessness.

Could fund an expert counsellor to run a support group session for young adults with a life-limiting illness, helping them feel less alone.

Nurse Specialists
